Research Scholarships:

Target Group	⇔	Highly qualified postgraduate researchers from all academic fields as well as young Medical Doctors
Eligibility Criteria and	⇔	Master degree or equivalent University degree
specific conditions	⇔	The candidate must not be more than 35 years old at the moment of the application
	⇔	Applicants who are in Switzerland since more than 1 year at the beginning of the scholarship are not eligible
	⇔	Applicants must provide a letter (e-mail) from a Professor from the Swiss host institution stating that he/she is willing to supervise the Research
	⇔	Applicants must have a research proposal including a timeframe (this is the central piece of the application. The applicant must devote all required attention to it)
	⇔	Applicants who have already benefited from a Swiss Government Scholarship are not eligible for a new scholarship
	⇔	Applicants must be in command of the necessary language skills required for the Research
Duration	⇔	12 months maximum (non renewable)



Postdoctoral Scholarships:

Target Group	⇔	Highly qualified postdoctoral researchers from all academic fields
Eligibility Criteria and	⇔	PhD degree
specific conditions	⇒	There should not be a gap of more than 5 years between the award of the PhD and the application deadline
	⇒	Applicants who are in Switzerland since more than 1 year at the beginning of the scholarship are not eligible
	⇒	Applicants must provide a letter (e-mail) from a Professor from the Swiss host institution stating that he/she is
		willing to supervise the Research
	⇒	Applicants must have a research proposal including a timeframe (this is the central piece of the application.
		The applicant must devote all required attention to it)
	⇒	Applicants who have already benefited from a Swiss Government Scholarship are not eligible for a new
		scholarship
	⇒	Applicants must be in command of the necessary language skills required for the Research
Duration	⇔	12 months (renewable maximum 6 months)
Duration	⇔	12 months (renewable maximum 6 months)



Fine arts scholarships:

Target Group	⇔	Highly qualified young artists from all artistic branches. Master scholarships are only offered to citizens of the countries with which Switzerland has a direct reciprocity agreement in the realm of arts scholarships
Eligibility Criteria and specific conditions	* * * * *	 Bachelor degree or equivalent degree The candidate should not be more than 35 years old at the moment of the application Applicants who are in Switzerland since more than 1 year at the beginning of the scholarship are not eligible Applicants must apply to the chosen Conservatory or Art School as well as for the scholarship. The two procedures are separate ones Applicants who have already benefited from a Swiss Government Scholarship are not eligible for a new scholarship Applicants must be in command of the necessary language skills required for the PhD program
Duration	⇔	The duration of the Master program (according to the ECTS credits)



The application Package:

The 2014-2015 application package has to be sent by e-mail to the prospective candidates. It includes:

- 1) Application guidelines
- 2) 2014-2015 application form
- 3) Project proposal form
- 4) Recommendation letter form
- 5) Medical certificate form

IMPORTANT POINTS

- o Applicants must apply for <u>only 1 University</u>. Applicants who have applied for 2 or more Swiss Universities (Ex: ETHZ & EPFL) will not be taken into consideration by the Swiss Diplomatic Representation.
- o The candidate wishing to apply for a Research Fellowship, à PhD or a Postdoctoral scholarship must get in contact with a Professor in a Swiss academic institution who agrees to supervise the research. A copy of this confirmation must absolutely be joined to the application.
- For Research Fellowships, Postdocotral Fellowships as well as PhD Scholarships: a complete research proposal (max. 5 pages), using exclusively the official research proposal form provided with the application package (see. APPLICATION GUIDELINES);
- Applicants who have already benefited from a Swiss Government Scholarship are not eligible for a second scholarship



Applications will not be taken into consideration if they are in one of the following situations:

- o The applicant does not fulfill the eligibility criteria stated on the FCS website and application guidelines
- o The application is incomplete, does not respect the guidelines, does not include the proper FCS forms or is badly prepared
- o Applications for 2 or more Universities
- o Applicants do not have an invitation letter from a Professor willing to supervise the research in one of the Swiss Academic institutions
- o Applicants who have already benefited from a Swiss Government Scholarship are not eligible for a second scholarship
- o Applicants are in Switzerland for more than 1 year at the beginning of the scholarship.
- All applicants whose applications are rejected must receive a written communication stating that their application has not been taken into consideration for the second round and as a consequence will not be sent to Switzerland.
